## WHAT TO EXPECT FROM US

**Clean Environment:** We are disinfecting surfaces regularly for your safety.

**Sanitation Stations:** We are providing hand sanitation stations throughout the convention center.

**Healthy Staff:** We only attend SON when feeling healthy to ensure a safe environment.

**Contactless Options:** We have contactless options for CE Verification and Registration.

**Wearing Masks:** Masks are encouraged, but not mandatory for staff.



## WHAT WE EXPECT FROM YOU

**Wear a Mask if Not Vaccinated:** Per CDC guidelines, unvaccinated attendees should wear a mask when in public spaces.

**Hand Sanitation:** We ask that you use hand sanitizer and wash your hands frequently.

**Stay Home if Feeling Sick:** We ask that you please stay home if you are feeling unwell, experience COVID-19 symptoms, or have been in contact with someone with COVID-19.

**Coughing & Sneezing:** We ask that you cover your mouth and nose with your elbow or tissue when coughing or sneezing.



## WHAT TO EXPECT FROM THE SAINT PAUL RIVERCENTRE

**Hand Sanitation:** 100+ hand sanitizing stations are located throughout Saint Paul RiverCentre.

**More Frequent Cleaning:** Public and high touch areas are cleaned and sanitized on an ongoing and frequent basis.

**Clean Air:** Upgraded heating, ventilation, and air conditioning filters.

**Food Safety:** Enhanced safety protocols for food and beverage service.

**Staff Health & Safety:** Employees who are sick are not allowed to work.
